**1. To Approve the Minutes of the Previous Meeting**

Minutes of the Annual Lighthorne Parish Meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2003 were circulated. David Booth proposed that they be accepted as a true record; Lou Giblin seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.

**2. Parish Split**

Cllr Rigby circulated copies of the Lighthorne Parish Council Annual Review for 2004 and explained that the current situation was as outlined in that document. In summary, the Office of the Deputy Prime Minister (ODPM) had accepted the split as proposed by Stratford-on-Avon District Council (SDC) and the split was effective the day following this meeting (1<sup>st</sup> April 2004). The current Councillors had been directed to run the two new Councils until after the elections, which would take place on 10<sup>th</sup> June this year.
